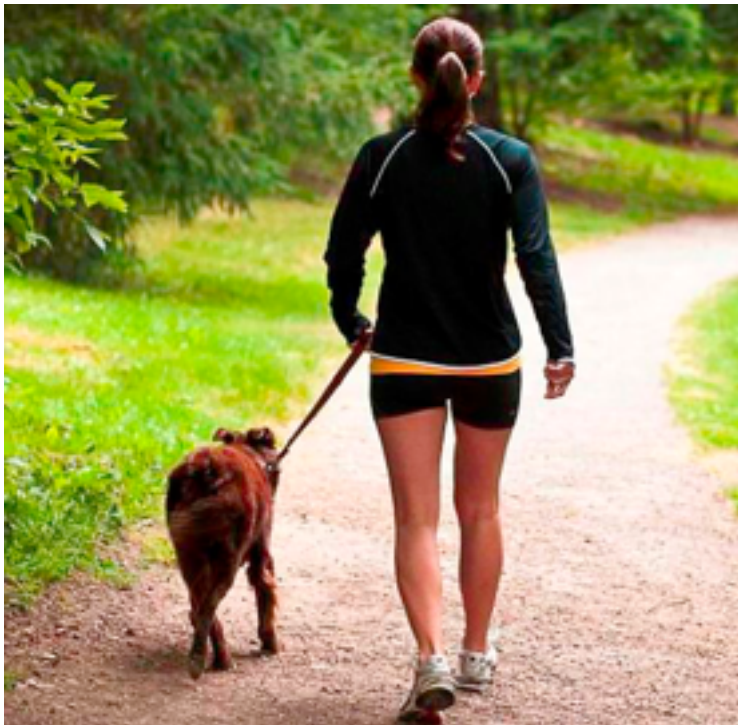

Spring is here! We are all loving to get out and enjoy the rising temperatures. That includes those who are walking their dogs. Your neighbors like seeing the

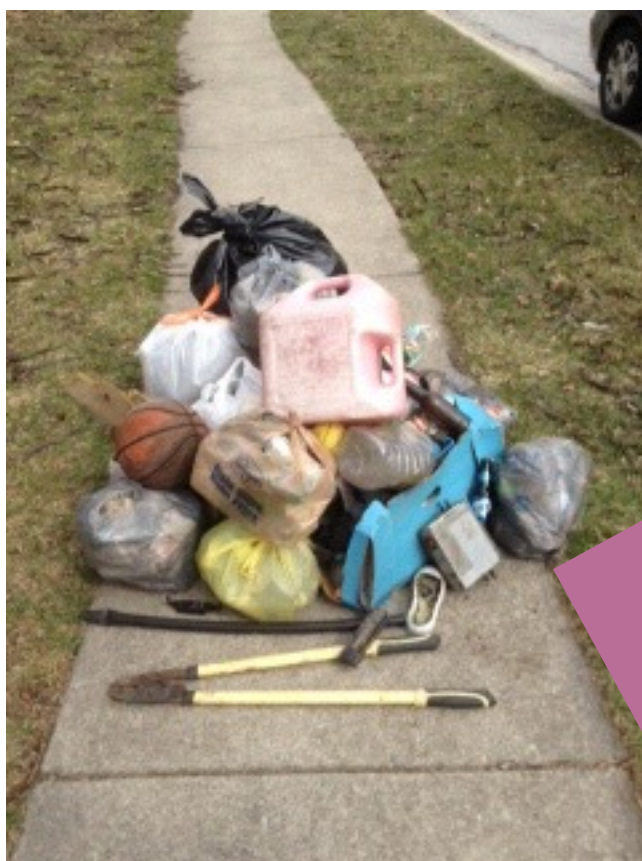

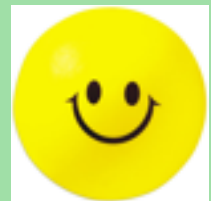
Advertising Available
